

ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY (AUP)

1. Scope

This Acceptable Use Policy (“Policy”) applies to all websites, applications, and hosted services operated by CinePath Ltd, including Cine3D, Cine3D Pro, ConveyoPro, CineDRAW, and any future platforms or subdomains under the CinePath name.

By using any CinePath system or service, you agree to comply with this Policy and all applicable laws and regulations.

2. General Principles

CinePath Ltd systems are designed for legitimate business, engineering, and manufacturing use only. Users must act responsibly, respect others, and maintain the integrity and security of CinePath systems at all times.

Any use of CinePath services that interferes with normal operations, compromises security, or violates the law is strictly prohibited.

3. Prohibited Activities

The following actions are expressly forbidden under this Policy:

a. Illegal or Infringing Content

Uploading, transmitting, or storing any material that:

- Violates UK law or the rights of others.
- Contains obscene, defamatory, or discriminatory content.
- Infringes intellectual property rights, including patents, trademarks, or copyrights.

b. Malware and Security Breach Attempts

Users must not:

- Upload or distribute viruses, worms, trojans, or other malicious software.
- Attempt to access systems, accounts, or data without authorisation.
- Probe, scan, or test system vulnerabilities.
- Bypass authentication, encryption, or security mechanisms.

c. Network and Service Abuse

It is prohibited to:

- Launch denial-of-service (DoS) or spam attacks.
- Use automated tools, bots, or scrapers to collect data or overload CinePath systems.
- Distribute content intended to disrupt service or degrade system performance.

d. Impersonation and Misrepresentation

Users may not:

- Impersonate CinePath staff or other users.
- Misrepresent their identity, affiliation, or authorisation to use any service.
- Use CinePath logos, branding, or trademarks without prior written consent.

e. Unauthorised Data Use

Users must not collect, access, or disclose personal or confidential information belonging to CinePath, its clients, or partners without written permission.

4. Monitoring and Enforcement

CinePath Ltd reserves the right to monitor network traffic and system activity to ensure compliance with this Policy.

Violation of this Policy may result in immediate suspension or permanent termination of user accounts or access without prior notice.

CinePath also reserves the right to cooperate with law enforcement and pursue legal action against individuals or organisations engaged in prohibited activities.
